CLI History/Background

Christian Leaders Institute (CLI) started in 2006 by offering free courses for students to earn certificates, awards, and diploma credentials. January 1, 2015, brought a new dimension to CLI with the launch of the undergraduate degree programs. Degrees and credit are earned through our Leadership Excellence School. Students in the Christian Development School may earn units or modules toward awards, certificates, and diplomas. CLI's headquarters are located in Largo, FL, with an office location in Michigan as well.

Accreditation

Christian Leaders Institute holds candidate status with the Association for Biblical Higher Education Commission on Accreditation (5850 T. G. Lee Blvd., Ste. 130, Orlando, FL 32822, 407.207.0808). Candidate status is a pre-accreditation status granted to those institutions that meet the ABHE Conditions of Eligibility and that possess such qualities as may provide a basis for achieving accreditation status within five years.

Academic Calendar

Christian Leaders Institute's academic calendar consists of three four-month semesters. First Semester consists of the months January-April, Second Semester consists of the months May-August, and Third Semester consists of the months September-December.

Degree Requirements

The highest degree offered by CLI is the bachelor degree. For the bachelor degree, students must have earned a minimum of 123 credit hours with a cumulative GPA of 2.0 or higher and successfully completed the degree's capstone course. For the associate degree program, students must have completed 64 credit hours with a cumulative GPA of 2.0 or higher and successfully completed the degree's capstone course. Degrees currently offered are Divinity, Chaplaincy, and Christian Leadership.

Calculation of Credit Hours

Christian Leaders Institute examines each course individually before it becomes available to students to determine the semester credit hour value that CLI would be able to award to a student who completes that course. The number of hours assigned to a course is determined by the amount of time required for directed study, depth of the course, and class interaction. In calculating credit hours for a course, CLI uses the following definition: one semester hour is awarded when the student completes at least fifteen 50-minute hours in class and thirty 50-minute hours of work outside of class

Christian Development School Units Versus Modules

Any college-level courses completed by a Christian Development School (CDS) Student are listed as "units" on the student's transcript and are transferable to CLI's Leadership Excellence School as college credit. The transfer ratio is 1 unit = 1 credit. The introductory course, Alliance courses (ordination, licensing, officiant, field), the Multiplying Christian Leaders course, "English Literacy for Beginners" courses, and "Ministry Skills" category courses give "modules" on the CDS transcript instead of units and are not transferable to the Institute's Leadership Excellence School.
